This qualification covers a wide range of job roles in end of life care within health care and social care. This qualification will equip you with the skills and knowledge you need to work in the health and care industry in the specialist end of life area.

Social care is about helping people with diverse needs and ages. This type of care takes place anywhere in the community, from people in their own homes to hospices, hospitals and care homes.

- Understand how to work in the end of life sector.

How will I be taught?

You will be taught via workshops with our experienced team of End of Life specialists.

Progression to higher levels of study within Health including Level 3 Diploma and Apprenticeships.

The qualification will be delivered at St. Catherine's Hospice in Lostock Hall, Preston.

How will I be assessed?

You will be allocated an occupationally competent assessor who will assess your practices within your workplace. You will also be assessed via assignments, research and observations.
